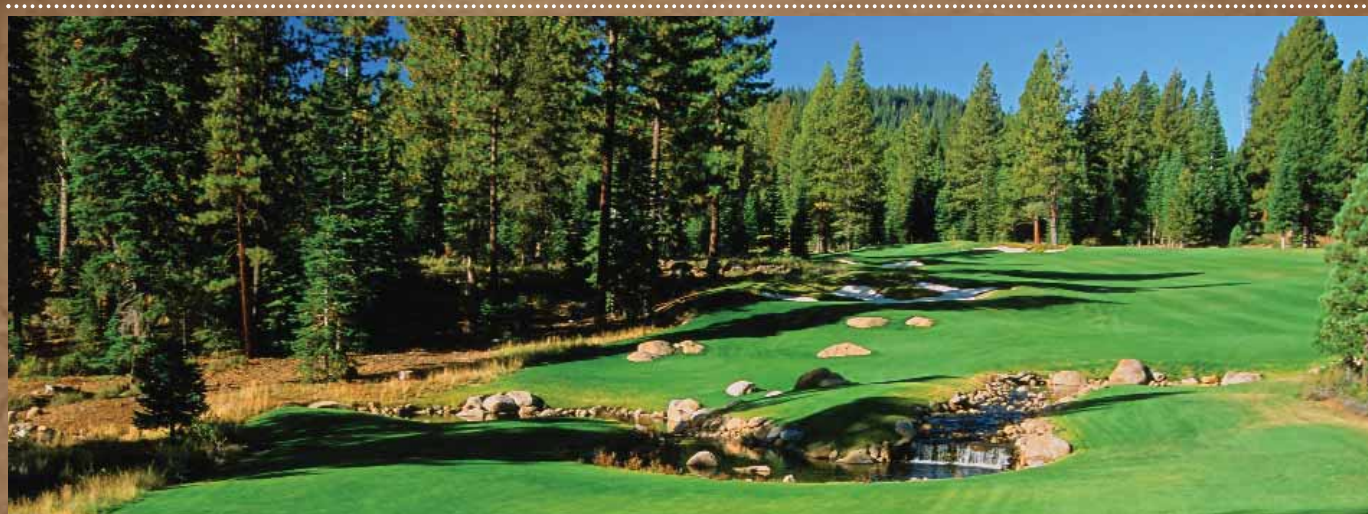

CONGRATULATIONS TO LANDON HART

Congratulations to Schaffer's Mill member Landon Hart for winning the PAL (Peninsula Athletic League) Individual Golf Championship back in early May. Hart shot an opening round 73 at Shoreline Golf Course in Mountain View, then shot a second round 77 at the Old Course at Half Moon Bay to amass a two-day total of 150, three shots better than the nearest competitor. Hart, a sophomore at Aragon High beat out a number of talented juniors and seniors. According to Aragon Golf Coach Guy Oling, “Landon put his game together. He was hitting the ball well, he was making good course management decisions on what club to hit, where to hit it and read the greens well. For Landon to be among a group where the majority is upper classmen, that's a real confidence booster for him.”

In addition to Landon's Individual Golf Championship, he was also named the San Mateo Daily Journal's Athlete of the Week.
